Next on the list is the burly PW150R, designed primarily for asphalt roofing applications. With a fastener range of ¾” – 1-1/2”, the PW150R is also capable of handling a variety of other applications, including corrugated carton to skid, furniture and cabinet frames, butt-joints and foam boards.

Rounding out the trio is the durable and lightweight PW150. Ideal for attaching corrugated carton to skid, furniture and cabinet frame assembly and butt-joint fastening, the capable stapler can also handle asphalt roofing and foam board installation.
